THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION ACTIONS WHICH ARE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 1094.6 AS ADMINISTRATIVE DECISIONS ARE THE HEARINGS CONDUCTED BEFORE THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION REVIEWING THE DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS OF THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY WHEN SAID ACTIONS ARE APPEALED TO THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION. THE ACTIONS INCLUDE THE SUSPENDING, DEMOTING, OR DISMISSING OF A PERMANENT EMPLOYEE IN THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

THE DECISION OF THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION IS FINAL FOR PURPOSE OF COMMENCING THE NINETY (90) CALENDAR DAY STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS UPON THE FILING OF THE WRITTEN DECISION AND FINDINGS IN SUPPORT OF THE DECISION.
