In September 2013, Council adopted a goal to “Enhance Community Sports and Recreational Assets” with a particular focus on addressing the immediate demand and impact on existing facilities and the need for future community recreation facilities. On February 3, 2015, Council considered conceptual designs for the parcel at the southwest corner of Monroe Blvd. and San Tomas Expressway, and directed staff to continue development of one of the concepts.

In November 2015, Council approved proceeding with planning, design, engineering and community input for a Neighborhood Park and Community Garden on the site. The park elements to be included are: a community garden, playground, restroom, bocce courts, grass meadow and picnic area in addition to the existing Bike Trailhead and parking. You are invited to attend the first public workshop to provide design input on Wednesday March 9, 2016 at 7 p.m. at the Santa Clara Teen Center.
