It is obvious that the whole process was bungled from the get-go, since signed agreements of intent between the three parties never existed. It is hard to imagine those concerned; the City of Santa Clara, the 49er's or Cedar Fair, would seriously consider undertaking such a costly venture without clearly understanding what the other two desired before spending any money.

Additionally, if the proposal is so costly and enormous as you the City Council and Staff suggest, and assuming you want to avoid anymore political backlash, there definitely is a requirement of public discussion and approval before entering into any kind of long term agreement.

Other than an outright declination of the initial stadium proposal by the

council, which is hard to imagine or considering one of many proffered alternatives, the issue of whether the city residents even want a stadium still exists. A ***public vote*** on the matter is slowly getting lost in the fog of imaginary dreams and supportive documentation someplace.

Will Santa Clara ***vote*** to determine whether the stadium should ever be built ?
