Residency in Santa Clara comes with special benefits that are only on a wish list for people who live in other nearby communities. The annual Clean Up campaign provides free, unlimited pick up of old furniture, appliances and other discarded materials. Combined utility rates for Santa Clara customers are the lowest in the Bay Area, and City utilities receive high approval marks for customer service and reliability.

This year is the 5th anniversary of free outdoor WiFi service throughout Santa Clara. Another technology innovation is the availability of multiple options for watching City Council meetings real-time including Comcast Channel 15 and live streaming on City website, Facebook and YouTube. Santa Clara is the first city to offer so many opportunities and the effort won an Award of Distinction from California Association of Public Information Officers.
