

# DISCOVER YOUR HERITAGE



All residents, no matter where they came from or how long they have called Santa Clara home, are now part of the City's history. Santa Clara takes great pride in its diverse population and the rich cultural heritage that is created when people of different backgrounds and nationalities live side by side in one community.

Residents are encouraged to explore the history of Santa Clara from its early days as a mission outpost to its incorporation in 1852 and through its evolution from a thriving agricultural community to its current status as the world center of innovation and technology.

Learning more about your personal heritage is the goal of a robust genealogy program at the Central Park Library Heritage Pavilion, where free classes guide residents on the search for their ancestors. It also is home base to the Santa Clara County Historical & Genealogical Society.
