Santa Clara has an international reputation as the headquarters of major corporations, but it is also the home to hundreds of small businesses and entrepreneurial start-ups that find the City understands the needs of business. New national retailers opened in Santa Clara in 2016 and more are on their way. A vibrant business community provides jobs and economic stability.

For 80 Olympic medal winners over the past 50+ years, Santa Clara was where they had the opportunity to excel in swimming, diving and synchronized swimming. Santa Clara was named the #1 aquatics community in the nation by USA Swimming, a 400,000-member organization. Plans for a new International Swim Center and Hall of Fame in Santa Clara will become more detailed in 2017.
