## **Santa Clara Sculpture Exhibition “Out of the Darkness, Light” Opens April 9**

**Background:** The City of Santa Clara’s 8<sup>th</sup> Biennial Indoor Sculpture Exhibition opens to the public on April 9<sup>th</sup>, with displays of artwork in both City Hall and the Central Park Library. This year’s theme, “Out of the Darkness, Light”, inspired multiple artists to incorporate LED, Electro-Luminescent wire, and fiber-optic light features in their sculptures.

25 artists were selected to display at the exhibition. Many of the artists involved have participated in other national and international exhibitions and received awards throughout the Bay Area, and some have previously displayed their work in Santa Clara’s own Triton Museum. Of note are several artists who have recently entered the juried art show circuit, including artists who have created art works for the Burning Man festival. Reflecting modern “maker” and kinetic features, the sculptures’ media ranges from porcelain and metal, to found objects, to 3-D printed material, to laser-cut acrylic.
