- One in 10 high school students in the U.S. has been purposefully hit, slapped or physically hurt by a boyfriend or girlfriend
- 25% of high school girls have been victims of physical or sexual abuse or date rape
- Only 33% of teens in an abusive dating relationship ever told anyone about it
