TASMAN EAST SPECIFIC PLAN

OF COMMUNITY MEETING

The City has initiated the planning process for the Tasman East area and is holding a community meeting to obtain input on a vision for the area.

The Tasman East Specific Plan will create a framework for the development of a high density transit-oriented neighborhood (currently proposed to be up to 100 Dwelling units per acre), along with supportive retail services. The specific plan would lay out allowed uses, densities and height limits in the Tasman East area. Connections to the existing Guadalupe River trail, potential locations for parkland, and strategies for better access to transit will also be incorporated into the plan. The project area is an existing industrial neighborhood 45 acres in size, and is bounded by Tasman Drive to the south, the Guadalupe River to the East, the Santa Clara golf course to the north, and Lafayette Street to the west.
