Summary of Actions Taken/To Be Taken:

- Pruneridge@Cronin Traffic Signal
 - Start design April/May 2017
- Pruneridge@Pomeroy westbound right turn lane
 - Extend Lane markings and relocate signs
- Keep Clear markings and signs
 - Installed @ Tracy Dr, Geneva Dr, Rosemont Dr, Harvard Ave,
 Norwood Cir, Hillsdale Ave, Hudson Dr, & Meadow Ave*



Summary of Actions Taken/To Be Taken (Cont'd):

- Sight Distance @ side streets
 - Intersections reviewed red curbs/letters pending for Meadow, Hubbard and Rosemont
- Pruneridge congestion and queues
 - Queues observed ~1000ft during commute peaks, but all queues clear every signal cycle



Summary of Actions Taken/To Be Taken (Cont'd):

- 4 Thru Lanes and merge @ Harvard
 - Possible but will need removal of on-street parking
 - Cons: Increase of travel speeds and volumes, and left turn access
- Apple Traffic Study
 - Start in February/March 2017
 - Parking (Hubbard/Meadow areas) up to Calabazas Creek
 - Speed/Volume southside of Pruneridge west of Lawrence and to Jenny Strand Pk
