# QUESTIONS ABOUT "THE TROUBLE WITH PLAYING CUPID" Part 3

This book is a romance between two celebrities, December Brown and Tom Elmswood. December is a singer and Tom is a movie star. After being thrown together in a very embarrassing fashion, they spend the rest of the book trying to sort out their feelings for each other, although these feelings are never in doubt to the reader. The dialog is clever, glib, and quirky. It is how we all imagine we speak when we are at our best.
