A TALK WITH SJ TAIKO CO-FOUNDER, ROY HIRABAYASHI.

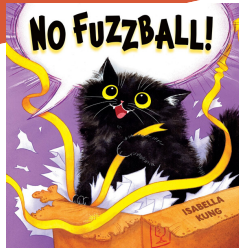

Roy Hirabayashi has been playing taiko and shinobue since 1973 and is one of the original founders of SJT and MALI Silicon Valley.

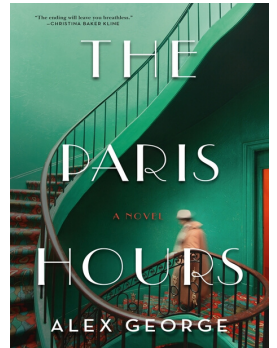

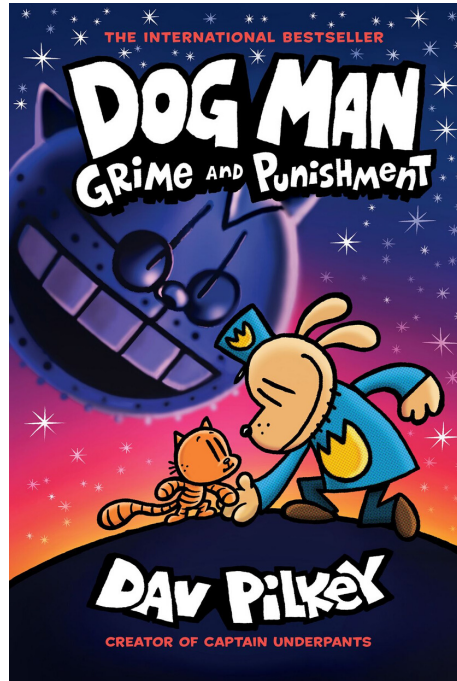


DOG MAN ESCAPE ROOM

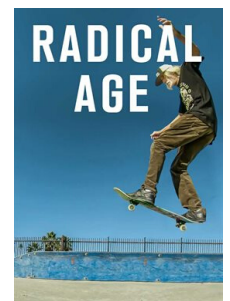

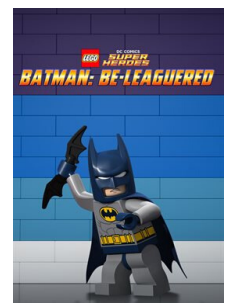

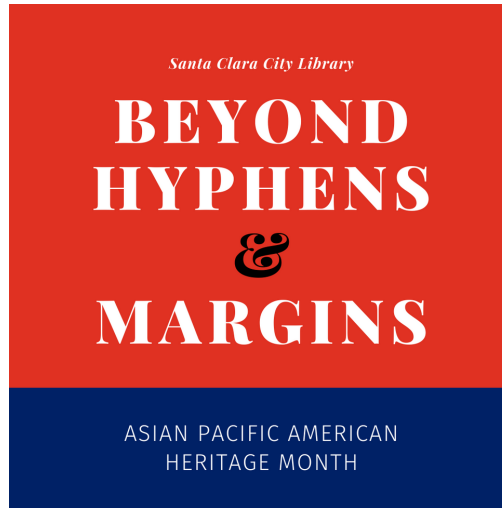

Asian Pacific American Heritage Month Celebration

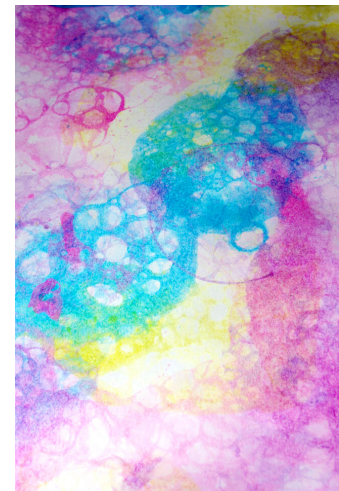
