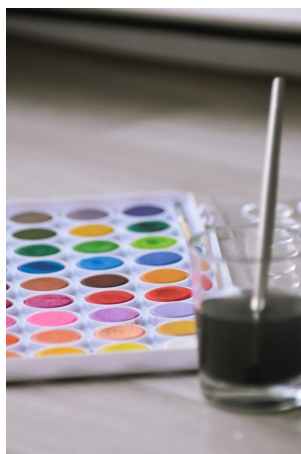
Accessing Small Business Reference Center
