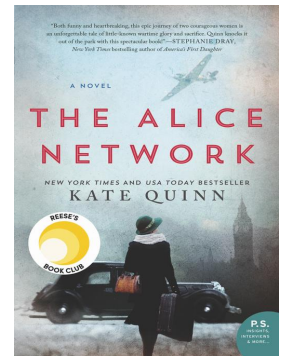


LEARN ASL STORYTIME

Learn ASL through songs, fingerplays, and books! Children ages 0-5 and parents are welcome to join virtual storytime.

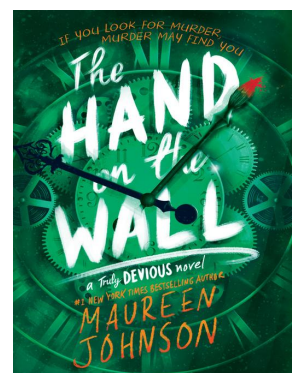
