During the closure no other Library services will be available, except online and digital, will be available. We look forward to seeing you in the New Year! All Library services will restart Monday, January 4, 2021.

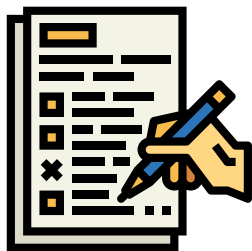

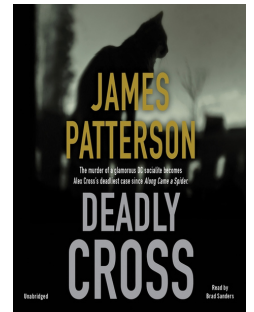
JINGLE BELLS STORYTIME

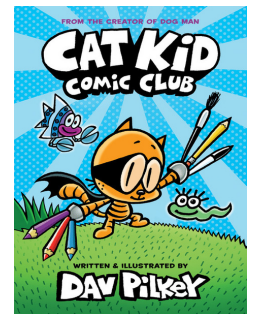

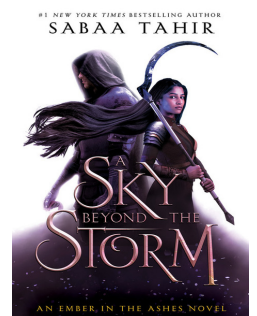
