**POLICE BLOTTER**

*The Police Blotter highlights a partial list of incidents in the city and is distributed on a weekly basis. The Blotter provides the date, time, approximate location, a narrative summary of the incident, case number and the most serious arrest charge.*

*Meanwhile, the Arrest Log provides a timely, chronological summary of all the arrests made by the Santa Clara Police Department. It includes the name of the suspect(s), date of birth, city in which they reside, arrest date, time, location, case number as well as all the charge(s) associated with the arrest. This information, located on the Santa Clara Police Department's home page ([www.scpd.org](http://www.scpd.org)), is updated daily and serves as the most comprehensive list of arrests made.*

**Sunday, December 13, 2020**

Commercial Burglary

Location: 700 Block of Scott Boulevard

A reporting party noticed a broken window to a business on the 700 block of Scott Boulevard and contacted Public Safety Dispatchers.

On arrival, officers noticed the glass window to enter the business was shattered. The unknown subject(s) stole several boxes of contact lenses, a credit card machine and training binders. The stolen items are valued at approximately \$2,350. The subject(s) are unknown and at large.

**Monday, December 14, 2020**

Warrant Arrest

Location: 2900 Block of El Camino Real

An officer conducted a registration check on a vehicle which revealed it was suspended. The officer initiated a traffic enforcement stop on the 2900 block of El Camino Real.

Petty Theft

**Wednesday, December 16, 2020**

Residential Burglary

Location: 2300 Block of Pilot Knob Drive

At approximately 1400 hours, three unknown subject(s) entered a residence on the 2300 block of Pilot Knob Drive through an unlocked rear sliding door. Four victims, two of which are juveniles, were inside the residence at this time. The subjects, one armed with a handgun, then took several items from the residence and demanded money from the victims. During the incident, one of the subjects took the victims phone against their will preventing them from contacting Public Safety Dispatchers to report the incident. The subject's fled with the victim's wallet, cash, cell phone and keys to a vehicle and the residence.

Public Safety Dispatchers were contacted, officers arrived on scene and met a victim outside of the residence. Officers entered the home to ensure the subjects had fled and to ensure the safety of the juveniles and an elderly resident that were still inside. Nobody was harmed during this incident.
