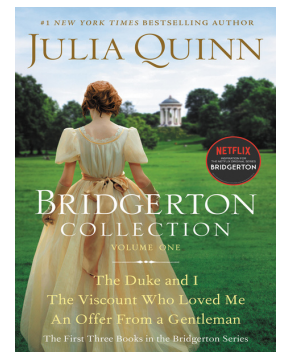


PROJECT SENTINEL: LANDLORD/TENANT COUNSELING

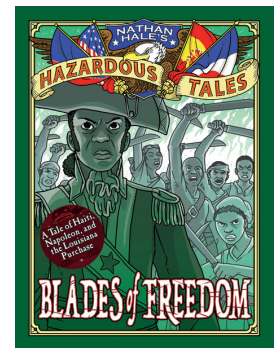
