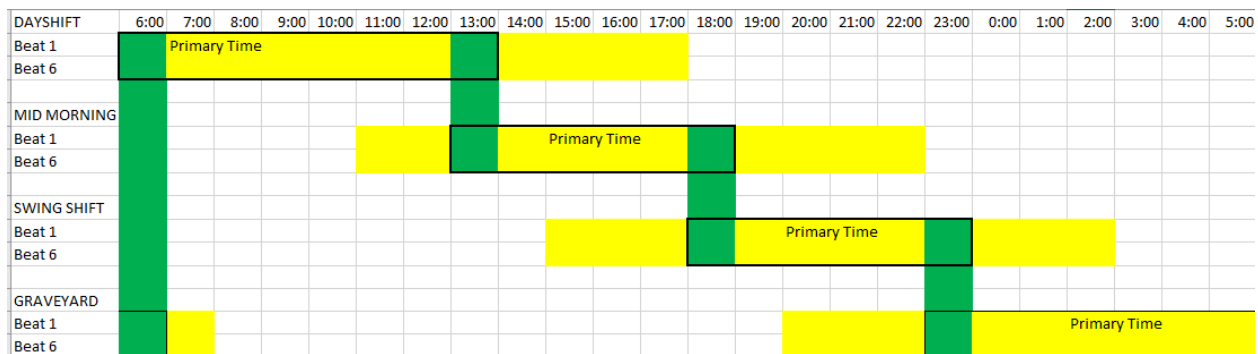


WRAP & AED Deployment Program

The WRAP & AED deployment program has been recently updated. It now includes the deployment of (2) WRAP devices into patrol cars. Deploying additional WRAP's into the field will help reduce the arrival time of a requested WRAP. An AED device will also be deployed with the WRAP. Additional AED's can still be deployed to field units.

Beat 1 and Beat 6 WRAP & AED Deployments:

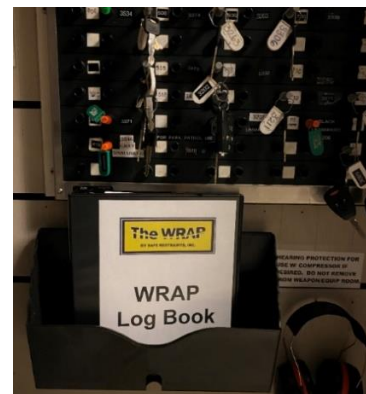
To start the rotation, dayshift beat 1 and beat 6 officers will retrieve WRAP #1 and WRAP #2 from the armory and an AED prior to going into service. The dayshift beat 1 and 6 officers will coordinate a hand-off of the WRAP & AED to the oncoming shift (mid-morning). This hand-off will continue to swing shift, graveyard shift, and then back to dayshift. The timeframe of the hand-off can be flexible to accommodate the uncertainty of our work. Below is the recommended hand-off schedule:

WRAP Identification & Log Book:

Each WRAP is identified with a dog tag. The WRAP log book will be located in the armory beneath the key rack. At the end of their shift (or when appropriate), the beat 1 and beat 6 officers will make a notation in the WRAP log book of possession and hand-off of the WRAP.



Hand-Offs When Out of Service:

Notify your supervisor (time permitting) if you will be extended at County Jail, VMC, or lengthy call for service. The WRAP & AED can be re-allocated to another patrol unit (please note the handoff in the WRAP log book).

WRAP Locations and Use & Care of the WRAP:

- WRAP 1 - Rotating in beat 1 car
- WRAP 2 - Rotating in beat 6 car
- WRAP 3 - (420) Sergeant vehicle
- WRAP 4 - (620) Sergeant vehicle
- WRAP 5 – Spare/Sergeants supply room
- WRAP 6 – THF
- WRAP 7 – (720) Sergeant vehicle
- WRAP 8 – (520) Sergeant vehicle
- Sergeants, please designate an officer to collect all WRAP components after use.
- Arrange to have the WRAP components cleaned after each use:
 - Ozone Sterilization after normal use (the JSO team can assist with the Ozone Sterilization)
 - (OR)
 - Bag contaminated WRAP components in biohazard bag (bags are in the evidence room)
 - Leave the WRAP in the biohazard bag for Tiffany Cleaners
- Keep track of your WRAP through the cleaning process until it is back in your vehicle.



Spare WRAP:

- WRAP 5 is the spare WRAP. Use this WRAP while your WRAP is being cleaned.
- If you take the spare WRAP, email your patrol Sergeant, patrol Lieutenant, Sgt Horn, and Ofc Janovich.
