## **CEW REMINDERS**

## Consider the following when deploying a CEW or other less lethal devices.

- Identify-Order-Warn (IOW) and give the subject a chance to comply before deploying the CEW, unless impractical to do so.
- Distance- Deploy CEW's from the proper distance in order to have the best chance of achieving Neuro Muscular Incapacitation NMI (deploying from too close makes it a pain compliance tool only).
- When- Only deploy against a violent/physically resistant suspect or suspect who has demonstrated an intention to be violent or physically resistant.

NWOO

- Location- No CEW deployments if suspect is on an elevated position (i.e. roof, fence, stairs, etc).
- **Handcuff-** When the suspect is under phase.
- Transition- If your CEW deployment is not successful load a new CEW cartridge or transition to another tool based on the suspects distance and actions.

## TAKEAWAY: Remember when we have time, set up a REACT team with clearly defined roles.

- **Lethal Cover-** 835aPC, AB 392.
- Less Lethal- Know the min/max effective distance and target location for the tool you are using.
- **Hands-** Handcuff under phase and communicate with your REACT team when moving up to 10-15.
- **Verbal Commands** IOW- Ex: "Police, get on the ground or you will be tased." The IOW changes depending on the order given and the warning of whatever force you will use.
