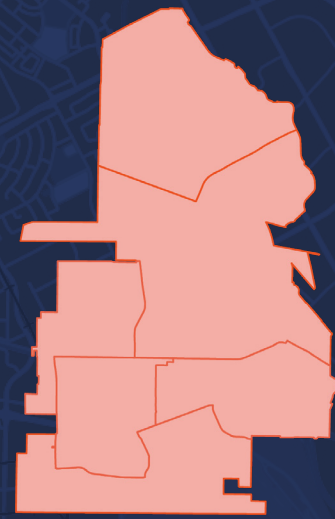

# Participate in **Redistricting** 2021-2022



**E**very 10 years, the City takes into account population changes reflected in the Census. The City has appointed the Independent Redistricting Commission for the effort to gather public input on the Council district map. During Redistricting, City Council districts are potentially redrawn so that each district is substantially equal in population and represents communities of interest.
