- Hours: Mon – Fri, 9am – 1pm. Can request help via online form during closed hours.
- Must be 65+ and live in West Santa Clara County; eligibility is by zip code.
- Must call 7 working days in advance, each time you need assistance. However, they do have a program called “In A Pinch” for urgent needs during business hours.
- Other services available; look at their website.
- They will send you a donation envelope after service. You pay what you can. No money is given to the volunteer.
