Architectural Review of renovations and roof repairs to a Request:

portion (86,700 square feet) of an existing 270,000 square foot shopping center involving exterior façade renovations and roof membrane replacement to the south and west buildings, including replacement of the loading dock enclosure behind the south building on the project site.

Categorically Exempt per Section 15301, Existing Facilities CEQA Determination:

Staff Recommendation: Approve, subject to conditions

Notice: The notice of public meeting for this item was posted within 500 feet of the site and was mailed to property owners within 500 feet of the project site.

Discussion: Ms. Fernandez provided a brief project overview and introduced the project team: Charles Kahn, Kim Fisher and Bob Olson, Mr. Kahn outlined the scope of the project and presented color boards illustrating the proposed changes, colors and materials to the existing building facades and loading dock at the rear of the south building.

The public hearing was opened and a discussion followed regarding timing and length of construction, treatment of the rear area (alley and wall) behind the existing building along the west property line, replacement installation of roof-mounted mechanical equipment, roof repairs, and potential for interior tenant improvements. The Committee expressed their approval of the project architecture, color palette and materials board.

The public hearing was closed.

Motion/Action: The Architectural Committee approved the project design (3-0-0-0), subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Provide color paint transitions where building change elevation/jog along the front facades.
- 2) Provide a minor treatment and/or accent color to the rear of the west building to add interest and break up existing visual massing.
- 3) Coordinate tile colors to compliment tile accents of approved new Walgreen's building.
- 4) Roof mounted mechanical equipment shall be screened from view along the public right-ofway and parking areas on-the project site.
- 5) Construction activity not confined within a building shall be limited to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. weekdays and not permitted on Saturdays for projects within 500 feet of a residential use. Construction activity confined within a building shall be limited to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. weekdays and 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturdays for projects within 500 feet of a residential use. Construction activity shall not be allowed on recognized State

- and Federal holidays. Implement pest control measures prior to the demolition of the structure.
- 6) The applicant shall designate a disturbance coordinator and post the name and phone number of this person at easy reference points for the surrounding land uses. The disturbance coordinator shall respond and address all noise complaints.
