FENTANYL Labeling

With the rise of the national fentanyl crisis, we are taking precautionary steps to ensure the safety of our Officers, Evidence CSOs, CSIs and Crime Lab partners.

When a substance with suspected fentanyl is booked into SCPD evidence:

- Place a BIOHAZARD sticker marked with FENTANYL on the KPAX.
- Apply the biohazard sticker on the outside of the KPAX.
