

✓ ACCEPTED MATERIALS:

All items must be generated from your home and placed at the curb in front of your residence.

- Furniture, carpet, mattresses, toilets, foam packaging, etc.
- Appliances, tires, e-waste (anything that uses a plug or battery to operate) untreated lumber, branches and brush (no longer than six-feet in length). **Separate each of these types of materials for special collection.**
- All concrete, asphalt, dirt, brick, rocks, drywall and/or sawdust MUST be set out in a heavy duty construction debris bulk bag to prevent debris from getting into storm drains. **Failure to use a bulk bag for these items is subject to a \$150 fine.**

Acceptable bags are made of tarp or thick plastic material made specifically for construction debris and can be no larger than one cubic yard in size.

Bulk bags may be purchased at a retailer of your choice or at the Municipal Utility Services counter located at 1500 Warburton Ave starting April 15. For current hours of operation, visit SantaClaraCA.gov/AccessSantaClara.

A total of 1 cubic yard of bagged debris will be picked up at no charge. Any additional bagged material will be collected for a fee of \$25/cubic yard, which will be added to the utility bill.

✗ ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- Pressure treated wood waste such as fence posts, railroad ties and decking must be disposed of as hazardous waste and **will not be collected during the Cleanup Campaign**. For up-to-date disposal options, please visit the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) at dtsc.ca.gov/toxics-in-products/treated-wood-waste.
- Contractor-generated landscape or construction/demolition debris.
- Household hazardous waste such as paint, batteries, pool chemicals, automotive fluids, solvents, fertilizers, cleaning products, compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs) and sharps. Visit HHW.org or call 408-299-7300 to schedule a free drop-off appointment. **Illegal set out of hazardous materials is subject to a \$500 fine.**
- Biohazardous waste or biomedical waste such as diapers, sanitary napkins, sharps and syringes, human and animal waste, and any other infectious materials.
- Ammunition and explosives—for safe disposal, call the Santa Clara Police Department at 408-615-5580.
- Medications—safely dispose of expired and unwanted medications at the MED-Project kiosks located throughout the City. For additional information and a list of locations, visit SCCMEDS.org.

ANNUAL CLEANUP CAMPAIGN

The Annual Cleanup Campaign is a service for Santa Clara residents ONLY. Eligible homes are able to set out bulky items not routinely collected by garbage, yard trimming and recycling curbside services.

THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Park vehicles in your garage or driveway during your assigned collection week. If you must park on the street, park at least five feet away from piles.
- Do not set out your materials before the specified dates for your area. **Early set-outs are subject to a \$150 fine.**
- Place materials on public streets at least three feet away from fire hydrants, fences, poles, cars, trees, bushes or walls. **Do not block sidewalks, driveways, bike lanes or access to blue or red curbs.**
- Contractors, businesses, and people from other communities setting out material is considered illegal dumping. To report illegal dumping in progress during business hours, call 408-615-3080 or 408-615-5580 after 4:30 p.m. or on weekends.

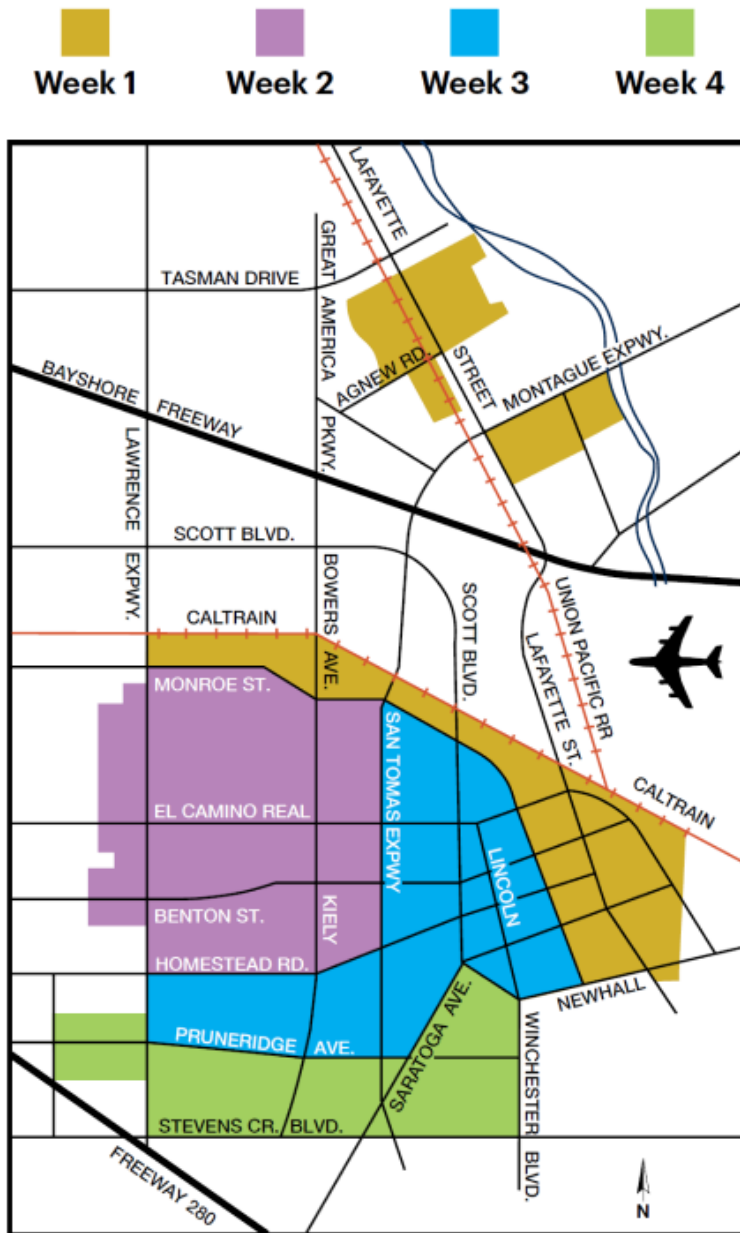

Annual Cleanup Campaign April 29 - May 24, 2024

Carefully check the map below for the correct collection dates for your street.



Week 1 – Set out materials no earlier than Saturday, April 27 and no later than 7 a.m. on Monday, April 29.
Note: Includes both sides of Monroe St.

Week 2 – Set out materials no earlier than Saturday, May 4 and no later than 7 a.m. on Monday, May 6.
Note: Includes both sides of Homestead Rd. between San Tomas & Lawrence Expressways.

Week 3 – Set out materials no earlier than Saturday, May 11 and no later than 7 a.m. on Monday, May 13.
Note: Includes both sides of Newhall St. between Saratoga Ave. & Winchester Blvd.; both sides of Saratoga Ave. between Scott Blvd. & Pruneridge Ave.; and north side of Pruneridge Ave. between Saratoga Ave. & Lawrence Expressway.

Week 4 – Set out materials no earlier than Saturday, May 18 and no later than 7 a.m. on Monday, May 20.
Note: Includes the south side of Pruneridge Ave. between Saratoga Ave. & Lawrence Expressway and both sides of Pruneridge Ave. west of Lawrence Expressway and east of Saratoga Ave.
