Holiday Tree Collection

Residential holiday trees will be collected curbside on your regular garbage collection days during the week of Jan. 6 – 10. Remove all ornaments, tinsel, nails and the stand from the tree. After Jan. 10, trees will not be collected, and residents should cut up trees and place the pieces in their green yard trimmings cart. Flocked trees are not accepted and should be cut up and placed in your garbage cart.

SANTA CLARA Minimum Wage Increase

\$18.20 Per hour

Effective Date: Jan. 1, 2025

2025 Minimum Wage

Starting Jan. 1, 2025, the City of Santa Clara's minimum wage will increase to \$18.20 per hour. Employers who are subject to the Santa Clara business license tax or who maintain a facility in Santa Clara, will be required to pay each employee who performs at least two hours of work a week in Santa Clara at least \$18.20 per hour. The City's minimum wage is adjusted annually based on the regional consumer price index.
